



2021 Lifetime Achievement Award in World Language Teaching Profession

FLAM is soliciting nominations for the Lifetime Achievement Award to be presented at the annual fall conference. The award honors a member of the world language teaching profession who has devoted his/her professional career to the improvement of world language learning. The honoree must be within two years of retirement or recently retired and must have been a member of FLAM for the past consecutive five years. The honoree must have a minimum of fifteen years of teaching experience at the elementary, middle, secondary, or post-secondary level.

I. Criteria for Nomination

Only current FLAM members can make a nomination. The nominees themselves may submit their own nominations. The nominee must have a minimum of 15 years of teaching experience at the elementary, middle, secondary, or post-secondary level.

All nominating and support materials must be sent electronically.

II. Information on the Nominee:

The following information is required (resume type):

- A. Educational background
- B. Missouri teaching experience
- C. Missouri professional lifetime achievements

III. Letters of Recommendation:

A minimum of two (2) letters must be submitted and may come from any of the following sources: principal, supervisor, departmental chairperson, deans, colleagues, current or former students.
